### Bow Divisions:

Compound, Recurve, Barebow, Basic Compound by USA Archery age groups.

Current USA Archery membership required.

Full payment is required at time of registration to hold your requested shoot time.

Competition Round: 60 Arrows at 18 meters  
(20 ends of 3 arrows)

**\*Age Categories: Bowmen (10-12) Cub (13-14) Cadet (15-17) Junior (18-20) Senior(21-49)  
Masters(50+) and (60+)**

**Collegiate, Para, W1, para compound & para recurve.**

Youth Age: \*The age you are on December 31st of 2017 is the group you shoot all of this year.

**Times: Saturday: 9:00am or 1:00pm Sunday: 10:00pm or 2:00pm**

This tournament is open to all USA Archery members however since it is the Virginia State Championships, the title of "Virginia State Champion" can only be awarded to members who reside within the boundaries of Virginia.

We will have other awards for our out of state guests who place in the top 3 of their division.

This is a combined event for the Virginia Indoor JOAD Championship and Indoor State Championship. Bowman, Cub, Cadets and Juniors may register for one or both of these events. Seniors and Masters will compete in the State Championship Only.

**Notice: For JOAD shooters only: If you are registering for BOTH events you will only shoot (1) 60 arrow round. Your score will count for BOTH events. You will not have to shoot (2) 60 arrow rounds.**

**Only JOAD age shooters who belong to a registered JOAD Club may compete in the JOAD State.**

**USA Archery members of any age may compete in the State Championship regardless if they belong to a club or not.**

**Please read this additional information to make your tournament experience a positive one..**

1. Please familiarize yourself and all participants with USA Archery Rules concerning equipment specifications and limitations and Dress Code.
2. **USA Archery dress code will be in effect and Strictly Enforced– For any USA Archery tournament, it is necessary to look neat and professional. Closed toe shoes, no sweats, No Camo, No denim jeans, . Clothing must cover midriff when at full draw. For specifics visit USA Archery website. Yoga pants must be covered by a skirt or shorts. See USA Archery policy for additional questions.**
3. Please arrive at least **30** minutes before your scheduled shoot time. This will allow the archer time to get set up and their equipment ready for inspection. We will start each flight On Time.

**\*\*\*\*\*Some things to remember for equipment inspection: \*\*\*\*\***

Arrows may be no larger than 23mm size and must be identical including fletchings and nocks. Arrow shafts must be marked with the archers initials or name and also have a unique number on each arrow. Mark the SHAFT, not the fletchings. Archers should bring ALL their equipment to the judge for inspection including, bow, sights, release aids, arrows. Bows must not be more than 60lb draw weight.

4. Barebow, Basic Compound, Recurve shooters in the Bowman and Cub divisions will shoot a **60cm** target face. Cadets and Juniors will use the **40cm** face or three spot as well as **ALL** compound shooters regardless of age division.

**All compound shooters will use Inner 10 Scoring.**

5. We have limited chairs available and invite you to bring your own chairs for this event. No open or spillable containers are allowed on the range. Ie, Mcdonalds cups, lids come off too easily. This creates a dangerous situation on the range so we ask that all drink containers have a secure closeable top. Someone always spills some thing even though we ask them not to bring drinks to the range area.
6. Our tournaments tend to fill up quickly, we recommend you register early. We have room for 144 shooters over the 2 days. Archers who are participating in both events scores will apply to both the JOAD and State Championships. Tournament only needs to be shot once.
7. When registering for a shoot time, please put your first choice, second choice etc.. for preferred shoot times. If we cannot offer your first choice we will immediately contact you either by email or phone. We will not contact you if we are able to offer your first choice. There is no need to call us to confirm, you can check and confirm your registration on the [www.archeryevents.com](http://www.archeryevents.com) website.
8. We must have your valid USA Archery member number to register for this tournament. We enter all information into the ArcheryEvents website. We also need a valid email address. If you have used Archery Events website before, please use that address when registering for this tournament.
9. If this is your first tournament please let us know. We want you to come prepared and have a good time.
